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***Zillah Family Medicine Clinic to Close,
Dr. Jonathan Davenport to Transition to Pacific Crest
Family Medicine Clinic***

YAKIMA — Memorial’s Zillah Family Medicine (ZFM) clinic will be closing, effective November 22, 2021. The clinic’s sole provider, Dr. Jonathan Davenport, will transition to Memorial’s Pacific Crest Family Medicine (PCFM) clinic in Yakima, where we encourage ZFM patients to join him.

Dr. Davenport, a Lower Valley native, says, “I have thoroughly enjoyed practicing and serving the Zillah community and hope my patients join me at my new location. Pacific Crest Family Medicine offers many benefits patients could not access at ZFM, including multiple highly experienced providers who can provide coverage if I am out, and proximity to our acute-care hospital and all of the quality services it offers.”

We understand this may create an inconvenience for patients and we apologize. However, Dr. Davenport will be expanding his schedule at PCFM on certain days each week, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., in order to accommodate his patient’s school and work schedules and the additional drive time.

This closure results from a combination of forces affecting the health care industry, including nationwide staffing shortages and the ongoing COVID-19 crisis.

If patients have an appointment already scheduled with Dr. Jonathan Davenport at ZFM on Nov. 23 or Nov. 24, please keep the same date and time, but it will be at PCFM. Staff will be contacting all patients scheduled on or after Nov. 24 to reschedule, as Dr. Davenport’s days in office will be changing to Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. If you have not seen the doctor in a while and need to reconnect, please call PCFM at 509-972-1818 to schedule an appointment.
