Patient/Family/Visitor Nondiscrimination Policy

Scope:

This policy applies to all members of the Yakima Valley Memorial Hospital Family of Services (YVMH FOS) workforce, including employees, medical staff members, contracted service providers, volunteers, vendors, students and any other individuals providing services to or on behalf of YVMH FOS under the category of "Hospital Personnel."

Definition:

Discrimination: Treatment or consideration of, or making a distinction in favor of or against a person or thing based on the group, class, or category to which that person belongs (i.e. race, religion, class or category).

Policy:
